Team Council shall limit the total time for public input on each topic to 20 minutes. With TEAM Council consent, the chair may increase or decrease the time allowed for public presentation depending on the subject and the number of persons wishing to be heard. 6. Confirm the \$15.36/hour rate for noon supervisors being paid out of LCAP (Action) – now an information item. 3 years ago, approved for noon duties to get \$15.36 per hour. Now that classified are part of CVCEO, supervisors should be still getting \$15.36 per hour, which enables us to maintain number of supervisors unlike other schools. CVCEO had to negotiate maintaining pay – following year, district will have caught up to pay. When they joined CVCEO district January paychecks reflected the rest of the district pay. Need Team Council approval to maintain \$15.36 pay. Could approve in May or possibly email vote. Supervisors need retroactive pay.
