    - Yes, there is a link and admin will send out one more time
  - Detailed Budget- instead of a general budget so that we know specifically where money is going
    - In the past there was a detailed budget by department
    - Staff would advise the TEAM council in that way
    - Can we resume that? TEAM council should have that information.
    - This information was shared last year, with the budget person in the district
      - We haven't been able to meet with Rita (new person)
    - Leticia De Los Santos is willing to go back and explain detailed itemized budget
    - \*Looking at it in small chunks would be better than reviewing the whole document at once.

## 9. Public Communication (Information)

- Anonymous (Teacher)—How has AVCS spent their funds? We never got an itemized breakdown. Where did all the money go?
- Parent—Safety at Arroyo Vista. No clear consequence. Student brought a gun to school.
  - Now I know that if a student brought a gun to school...there are no consequences
  - No police were called. Why?
  - One student's face was bleeding
    - Why did both students get back to the class the next day?
    - It is clear that other students can get away with anything
- Why are these meetings not advertised? I found the link on Facebook
- We are looking for more communication from the principal
- Parent—Thanks for posting the link on FB; I am new to the school. I would like to be more involved. I cannot find the school website.
- I have a question (I don't have access to unmute), for our middle school sports teams- since we are playing based on Sweetwater district rules, and they are requiring COVID tests prior to any games, can we get a test site on campus to help our teams? Maybe we can open it to the whole school?
  - Originally, we were supposed to have testing on site.
  - It's supposed to be every other week at our site.
  - Coach and Mrs. Baltierra have volunteered to do this
  - Mr. Mora—The school would have to pay for that.
    - We are about to start testing unvaccinated staff.
    - We need to find staff to do it.
- Teacher (Corinne Izgizon) – concerns about hiring a secretary
  - SLT was given a day notice and interview were during Parent/Teacher conferences
  - Tuesday no SLT member was present—there was no complete representation
  - Was other staff notified
  - I was told to cancel my conferences—
- Public (anonymous) – Member of Team council need to be dropped as voting members of the committee
- By-laws of the charter
  - Public notices need to be given and as a member of the council, I don't know how to find it
  - I cannot find it and I am Tech savvy
  - Recordings of past meetings should be posted on the website.
- We are out of compliance because we are not posting our meeting minutes online
- School Safety needs to be the focus going forward
  - Specially those involving weapons are not being
- Hiring procedures
  - SLT and parents need to be present
  - This has not been happening with current hires
  - SLT and parents should be contacted and should be aligned with community ability
