- Approval of Minutes from 10/20/2022
  Yesenia Mendoza motioned. Yvonne Dawson seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5. School Safe Plan
  - C. Quiroga presented the revised version of our School Safety Plan
  - School Wide Dress code has been revised and updated (TK 8<sup>th</sup> grade)
    - Handbook is getting updated and a presentation to middle school is in the works
    - No Middle School representative signed up to be part of the School Safety Committee
      - Middle School updated their hanbook in 2019 and this wasn't updated with the school safety plan
  - Matthew Pare moved to make a motion to approve the school Safety Committee
    - Update/aling Middle School Dress code
    - Add Middle School to list
  - Upon completion of items above, motion carried unanimously.
- 6. Expansion of DASH to 50 students
  - Currently at 30
  - Funded with ELO-P Grant

**Yesenia Mendoza** motioned to expand the DASH program. **Kelle Lemley** seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

- 7. ELAC/DLAC Report C.Quiroga
  - 11/16/22 Meetings were held
  - Re-classification data was reviewed.
  - AVCS had 3% of students were reclasiffied in 20/21, 13% reclasiffied in 21/22 and 14% in 22/23 were reclassified
- 8. Principal's Report
  - A. ILT Focus Area = Math (language use by ELs)
    - SMART GOAL = TK-2<sup>nd</sup> 80% of students will pass local measures
    - 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> minimum 65% of students will score meets or exceeds on CAASPP. Minimum of 5% of students from not met to nearly met, & 10% from not met/nearly met to met or exceeds.
  - B. Proposal to meet in person (to discuss and put up for a vote next meeting)
  - C. DASH will be providing an Intersession option for up to 10 students as a part of our grant agreement.
    - 1. We are doing this with Discover Charter (we are no longer doing this with the district as we had during the fall Intersession)
    - 2. The program will be from 7am to 5pm 1/3-1/6/2023 and 3/27-3/30/2023

3. We had 6 participants with very little notice in the fall. We expect it will fill up in the Winter and Spring.

D. By June of 2024 our charter is up for renewal. By 2023, we will have a draft so that when it comes time to present in March/April 2024 we can present the charter plan.

E. Juan Ricoy will be meeting with Bonnie McGrath to get a quote for support with the charter.
